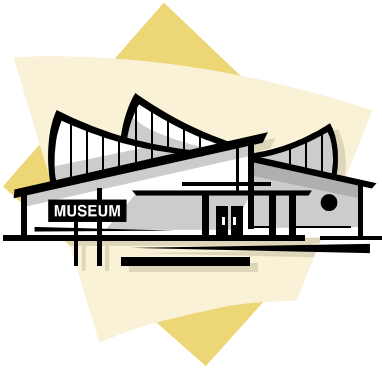


Perspectives of Russian Art

Join us for a talk by Ruthann Godollei, Professor of Art and Chair of the Art Department, at Betsy's Back Porch Coffee Shop followed by a tour of the Museum. Professor Godollei is a studio artist with an interest in worldwide arts. She teaches printmaking, design and art theory at Macalester College. A specialist in print media, her works deal with the human situation and concerns about social justice. Her artwork is in many collections such as the Belgian Royal Museum of Fine Art in Antwerp, the Croatian National University Library in Rijek, the Minneapolis Institute of Arts, the Weisman Museum in Minneapolis, Rutgers University and Louisiana State University.

She has been a four-time resident artist at the Frans Masereel Centrum for Graphics in Belgium. In June, 2004 she participated in the Associated Colleges of the Midwest faculty seminar on the Arts in Russia, held in Moscow and St. Petersburg.
