



## Minnesota Map Bingo

**Strand Identification:** V - Geography

### B. Essential Skills

**Standard 1:** The student will use maps, globes, geographic information systems, and other databases to answer geographic questions at a variety of scales from local to global.

**Benchmark: 1.** Students will demonstrate the ability to obtain geographic information from a variety of print and electronic sources.

**Grade level:** 5-12

**Overview:** Students will be looking at the antique maps in the Minnesota History Museum Minnesota Map exhibit and filling out their Bingo board based on the information found in a variety of different types and era maps of Minnesota.

**Time:** 1 class period or field trip to the museum.

**Subjects:** Geography, U.S. History, Minnesota Studies.

**Required Materials:** Maps found in the “Minnesota on the Map” exhibit at the Minnesota History Center.

**Objectives:** Students will be able to:

1. Find geographic information found in different types of maps of the state of Minnesota.
2. Discern important information from different types of maps of the state of Minnesota.

### Suggested Procedure:

The teacher should give a copy of the Bingo Board to each student in the class. Upon a tour of the different maps in the collection at the History Center of Minnesota, students will be able to answer different questions on their Bingo Board based upon the information presented on the maps.

**Suggested Assessment:** Teacher should collect the Bingo Boards upon completion of the field trip or the exhibit.
