# PLACE

- *“What’s It Like Outside?”*
  - *“What do you see with your eyes?”*
    - Trees, Lakes, Rivers, Animals, Buildings, Roads, Cars...

# Location

- Absolute: The Coordinates (exact location) Of A Place. “Deer River is located at 47° North & 93° West”
- Relative: A Guesstimate Of Where A Place Is. For Example: “Deer River is located between Cohasset and Ball Club.”

# Movement

- *“How People, Goods and Information Get Around.”*
- *Planes, Trains & Automobiles, Boats, Internet, Newspapers, Television and Radio etc...*

# Relationships

“Human Environmental Interactions”

- *“How People Interact With The Land For Fun and For Work”*
- Work: Outdoor Jobs...
- Fun: What do people do outside for fun

# Regions

- “World Within Worlds”
- What one place has in common with another.
- Deer River is a part of the following regions: Upper Midwest, Great Lakes, Vikings, Minnesota, “Hot Dish”, “Pop”, “Drinking Fountain”
