## PROCEDURES USED TO COMPUTE ACADEMIC YEAR ON-CAMPUS ENROLMENT

1. The Registration Summary Reports (prior to 2007-2008) and the Faculty Load Report serve as the source documents for this table. Counts include students receiving grades of W beginning in 2007-2008.
2. If a faculty member is teaching a course in another department or is appointed in more than one department, the students are credited to the department where the course is listed.
3. If a course is cross-listed, all students are credited to the department of the instructor of the course.
4. If a course is taught by more than one faculty member from different departments, the number of students in the course is divided by the number of instructors and the result (rounded up when necessary) is assigned to each faculty member's department.
5. Students enrolled in an interdepartmental or interdisciplinary course are credited to the department(s) of the instructor(s).
6. Students taking activity and practicum courses are counted as follows:
  - (a) Total number of students taking music lessons/ensembles from regular Macalester faculty is divided by four.
  - (b) Total number of students credited with theatre and dance practica is divided by four.
  - (c) Students enrolled in science, language, or other scheduled labs are not counted.
7. Students enrolled in a single credit colloquium or seminar are not counted.
8. January enrollments are computed by dividing the number of students registered for independent projects and internships by two. Registrations for off-campus courses are not divided by two.
