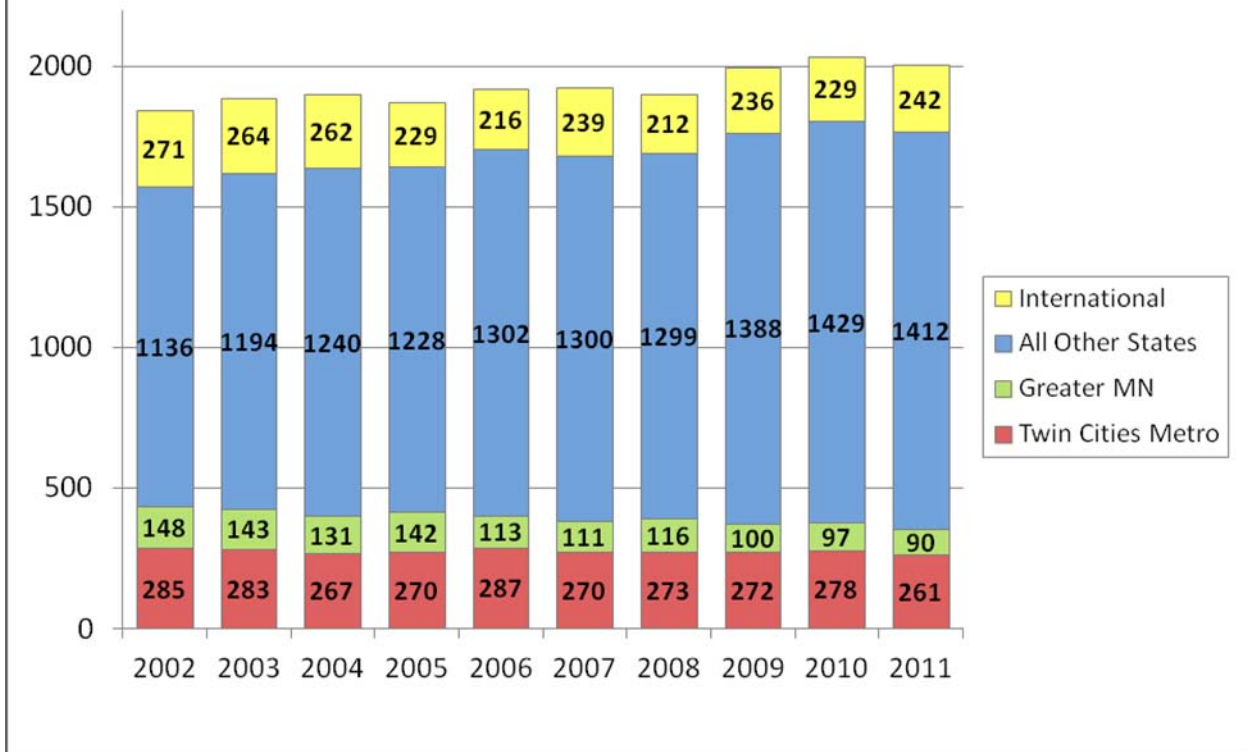

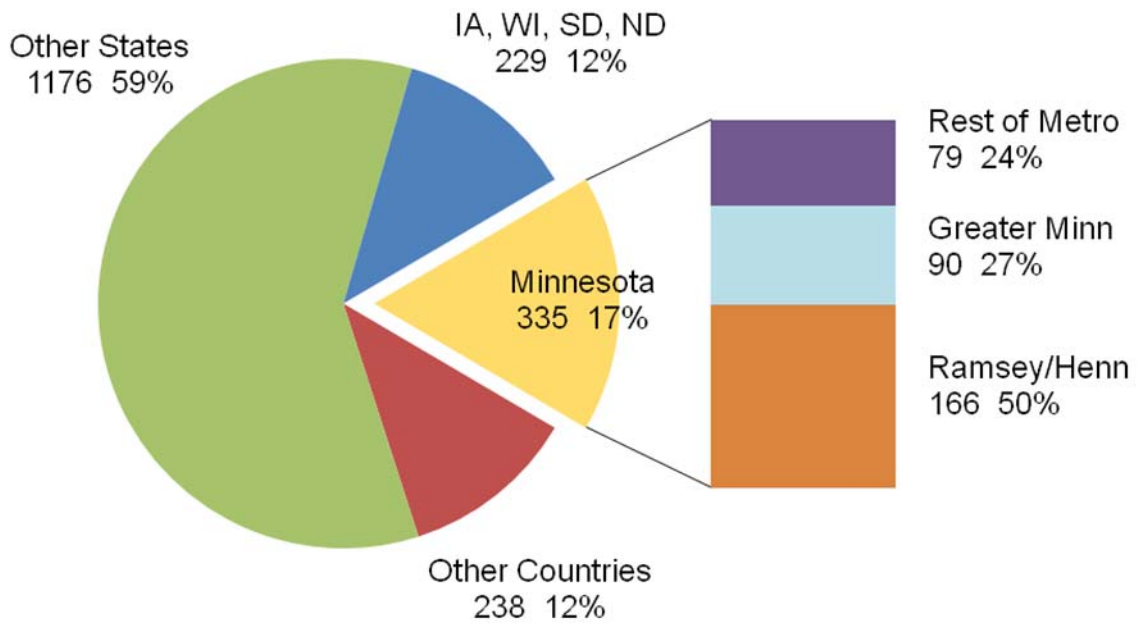

Geographic Enrollment All Students – Fall Semester



This chart shows the geographic enrollment of students in the fall semesters since 2002. Over the last ten years, the number of students from Minnesota has decreased from 433 in 2002 to 351 in 2011. Over the same time period, the number of U.S. students from outside Minnesota has increased from 1136 to 1412.

Geographic Distribution of Full Time Students – Fall 2011



Approximately 30% of the full time students this fall are from the Midwest. Roughly three fourths of the Minnesota students are from the Twin Cities Metro area.
