## MUGGING

At about 9:30 p.m. on Wednesday, November 9 a Macalester student was walking along the south side of Grand at Snelling (near the bus stop) and was approached by five or six males described below, who asked for a cigarette. The Macalester student did not respond and continued to walk on. Several moments later two of the perpetrators approached from behind and hit him in the face. The group immediately ran east on Grand Avenue. The Macalester student was not seriously injured. The St. Paul Police have been notified. The police reported that the same perpetrators mugged another person near Snelling and St. Clair Avenues. This second person was not a Macalester community member and was not seriously hurt. The St. Paul Police report that this does not appear to be a trend, and are at this time considering last night's episodes as isolated incidents.

A general description of all the perpetrators is as follows;

Gender: Male  
Skin tone: Dark  
Age: 16-21  
Height: Unknown  
Weight: Unknown  
Hair: Dark, cut close  
Clothing: Neatly dressed – dark jeans, dark jackets, one had a grey pea-coat  
Shoes: Sneakers, nice looking

Remember suspect information, including age, height, weight, hair, clothing, jewelry, scars, tattoos, vehicle information, and direction of travel – anything noticeable.
