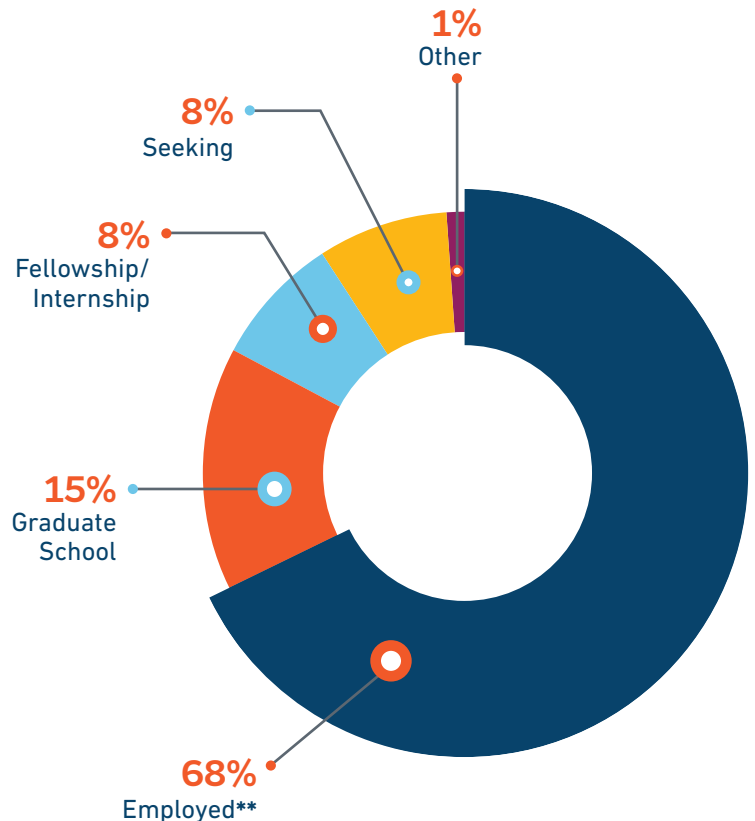

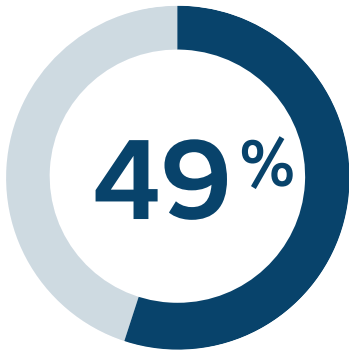
Percentage of 2025 graduates who say they have a job congruent with their interests

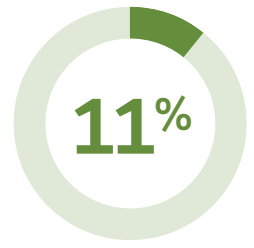

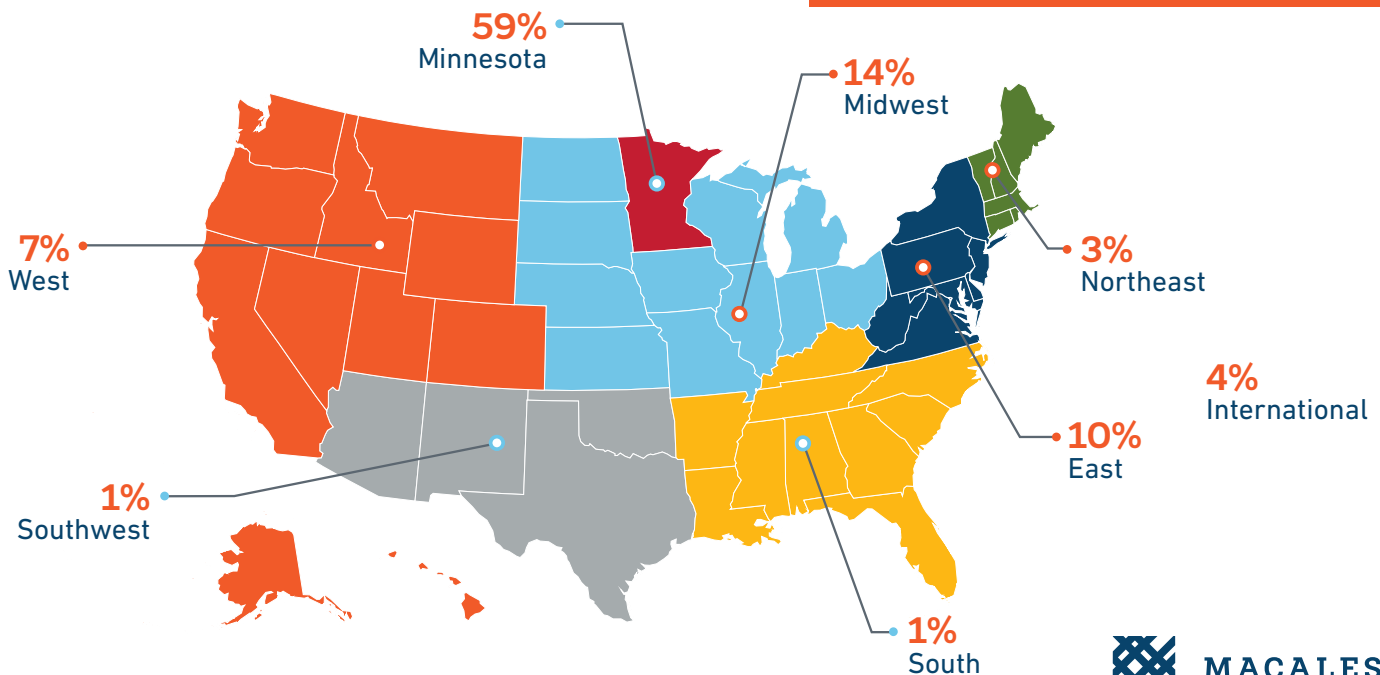
