



Taxable Prize or Award/Gift Form = Non-Macalester Recipients

Purpose

This form collects required information to report to the IRS the taxable portion of prizes or awards/gifts paid for by the College and delivered to individuals whom are NOT faculty, staff, or students of Macalester College.

Take note!

Gift cards and **gift certificates** purchased with College funds and awarded to Non-Macalester recipients are considered taxable income and are subject to withholding, <u>regardless of amount</u>. The tax code is quite clear that this applies to <u>all</u> gift cards, no matter how small the value. There are no <u>de minimis</u> exceptions. Even a \$5 gift card or gift certificate is considered taxable and must be reported to the IRS! <u>Policy statement "Prizes and awards/gifts to faculty, staff, and students"</u> will be followed as applicable for non-Macalester recipients.

It is the responsibility of the recipient to ensure reporting of taxable income. IRS reporting can be done by one of the following options:

- 1. Self reporting
- 2. Macalester College reporting (IRS form W9 required)
