



GABBY'S INSTRUCTIONS: RAT HAMMOCK











- 1. Cut two squares of two different fabrics. I usually do one patterned side and one solid colored felt fabric (softer for the rats to sleep on).
- 2. Fold in half and cut into triangles. Now there are two triangles of the pattern and two triangles of the solid color.
- 3. Lay and pin the pattern and solid on top of one another, with the "right" sides together.
- 4. Sew along the edges, but leave a small opening on one side so you can flip it right side out.
- 5. Trim the excess fabric.
- 6. Flip the hammock right side out.
- 7. Sew along the edges of the hammock once again, being sure to seal the opening.
- 8. In high school, I used grommets for each of the corners, but here, I just sewed an extra piece of solid colored fabric to the corners to reinforce them. The first hammocks I made got incredibly chewed up at the corners by the rats!
- 9. Repeat for as many hammocks as you want to make!
