Living in the EcoHouse will cost \$100 more per semester than the regular dormitory charge. In addition, I agree to work together with other house members to equitably delegate the tasks of house cleanliness, property upkeep, worm bin maintenance and communal meals. Communal meal times and frequency will be decided among house members as needed. They form a key opportunity to reflect on the experience, bond as a group, and discuss house matters.

I will help host 2-3 events throughout the semester, and will participate in regular meetings with the EcoHouse advisor, Prof. Christie Manning, to be scheduled at the beginning of each semester.
