- 1. GERC First-Year Course Update The group is working on a survey that will be coming out soon. Sources reviewed include history and current goals adopted in 2005, 2010 survey prepared by Erik Larson's students, along with data from 2014 campus environment survey, and advising task force report 2014. The plan is for the survey to be distributed the week after fall break.
- 2. Concentrations Policy Update Ernie gave a recap of the faculty meeting. General discussion focused on next steps. After much discussion, it was agreed to review our internal criteria and then proceed with pending new concentration proposals and eventually the pending reviews for existing concentrations.
- 3. Non Tenure-Track Faculty Voting Rights A meeting with NTT faculty was held at noon today and Ernie provided a report. Key concern was the issue of tying voting rights to a recommendation of 4 years of service. It was agreed that looking at peer institutions and a review of the history of voting and how it has changed over time would be helpful in framing the discussion.
