



How to handle charges from the Hamre Center for Health & Wellness

Nearly all services at the Macalester College Laurie Hamre Center for Health & Wellness are provided at no charge. However, there are some things that students will be charged for such as:

- Immunizations/vaccinations
- Lab tests (except pregnancy tests, which are free)
- Prescription medications/EC
- Physicals
- A few procedures (ear irrigation, etc.)

What to do if you incur a charge?

IF you have insurance other than the Macalester-offered plan:

- The **charge will be put directly on your Macalester student account**, identified only as “Health Service Charge”. You are responsible for paying the balance on your Macalester account. There are various ways to pay your bill, including credit card on e-bill. Check with the Business Office if you have questions about payment on your account.
- Ask the Center for Health & Wellness front desk for an **itemized statement to submit to your insurance for reimbursement**. You can then send it to your insurance company and they will pay you directly any amount that they cover.
- Or, you can **pay the charge directly** at the Center for Health & Wellness via check or cash.

IF you have the Macalester-offered insurance plan:

- All costs are covered at 100%.
- **No charges** are applied to your student account.
- Macalester Center for Health & Wellness will submit your charges to United Healthcare Student Resources – payment will come back directly to the Center to cover the charges.

IF you have questions or problems with what you have been charged for,

- Check in with the Center for Health & Wellness.
- Note: charges applied to your Macalester account will accrue interest if not paid in a timely fashion.
