Fall 2021 enrollment is the highest in Macalester's history


#### **Study Away Students**

#### **Retention Rates by Cohort**


Percent of each FY cohort retained Fall 2017 to Fall 2021

Cohort retention rates rebounded from the Fall 2020 dip. with 82% of student who were on leave in Fall 2020 returning for Fall 2021.

For most reporting on student race/ethnicity, IR uses a federally defined process based on 7 US Census categories. Race/ethnicity data is collected on first-year entry forms. International students are not asked to self-identify with US categorizations and are reported as "nonresident aliens." Domestic students who identify as 'Hispanic or Latino,' regardless of other racial/ethnic identifications, are counted as 'Hispanic/Latino' only.





#### Four-Year & Six-Year Graduation Rates by Cohort, 2010 - 2017

Cohorts = all first-time full-time incoming students (e.g., Fall 2017 cohort = Class of 2021)



**10%** of the Fall 2017 cohort are enrolled for a 5<sup>th</sup> year in Fall 2021 (n = 53 students).


This compares to **5% on avg.** for the previous 7 cohorts (n = 24 students on avg.).

### **Preliminary Employment Status of Grads: AT GRADUATION**

Class of 2017 – 2021; based on an annual May survey of graduating seniors. Avg. senior survey response rate = 70%

# Status of Graduates SIX-MONTHS-OUT

#### 91%

of recent graduates are "placed" by 6-months postgraduation (i.e., employed or in graduate school), with only 8% still "seeking."

[4-year average, '17 - '20]

NOTE: Official reporting on recent graduates' outcomes occurs at six-months post-graduation, NOT at May graduation when many seniors are still establishing their plans.

# New Faculty & Staff\*

\*Note: Counts are preliminary as of 9/10/21, and some staffing is still in flux. Official employee reporting happens after Nov. 1 each year. The number of new employees does NOT reflect new positions; most new hires have filled existing positions.

- **50** New faculty (full-time & part-time) are teaching at Mac in Fall 2021
  - 5 Full-time tenure-track faculty members
  - 25 Full-time non-tenure faculty members (e.g., visiting, NTT, post-docs)
  - 20 Part-time non-tenure instructors
- 87 New staff started at Mac since March 1, 2020 (excluding temp. employees)
  - **78** Full-time (1.0 to 0.75 FTE)
    - **9** Part-time (<0.75 FTE)

These counts include both Exempt (salaried) and Non-Exempt (hourly) employees

# Recent Retirements+

\* Note: Counts are for retirements only. Those who left Macalester for reasons other than retirement are NOT captured in this count.

- **45** Faculty and Staff have retired from Mac since March 1, 2020
  - 10 Faculty members
  - 35 Staff members
