More Students of Color

The number of U.S. students of color has grown 179%: from 210 to 585. In 2000, they were 12% of all students; they now comprise 28% of students. From 2000-2019, Mac's student body grew by 17%.

More International Students

The number of international students has grown 36%: from 235 to 319. In 2000, they were 13% of Mac students; they now comprise 15% of all students.

86%

More Faculty of Color

The number of full-time U.S. faculty of color has grown 86%: from 29 to 54. In 2000, they were 19% of full-time faculty; they now are 28% of full-time faculty. From 2000-2019, the faculty grew by 31%.

More Female Faculty

The number of full-time faculty who are women has grown 35%: from 78 to 105. In 2000, they were 44% of faculty; they are now 54%.
