

Macalester Graduation Rates

Fall 2018 Data



Macalester's current six-year graduation rate is 90%. This means that of the new first-year students who enrolled at Macalester in 2012, 90% had graduated by 2018 (six years after first enrolling). The remainder of the cohort has transferred, dropped out of college, or not yet completed their degree. This report is done in compliance with the federal Student Right-to-Know Act.
