Our telephone (455-6204) is equipped with a tape recorder which assures that it will be answered and messages will be received.

There are others who do not particularly care to be accompanied or ministered to but who prefer to walk about on their own. It certainly is not necessary to "make a reservation" for such purpose. In the occasional circumstances in which the entry gateway is closed there is easy access by foot through a stile alongside the gate. (The stile is intended to make easier foot access and to discourage the entry of wheeled vehicles.)
