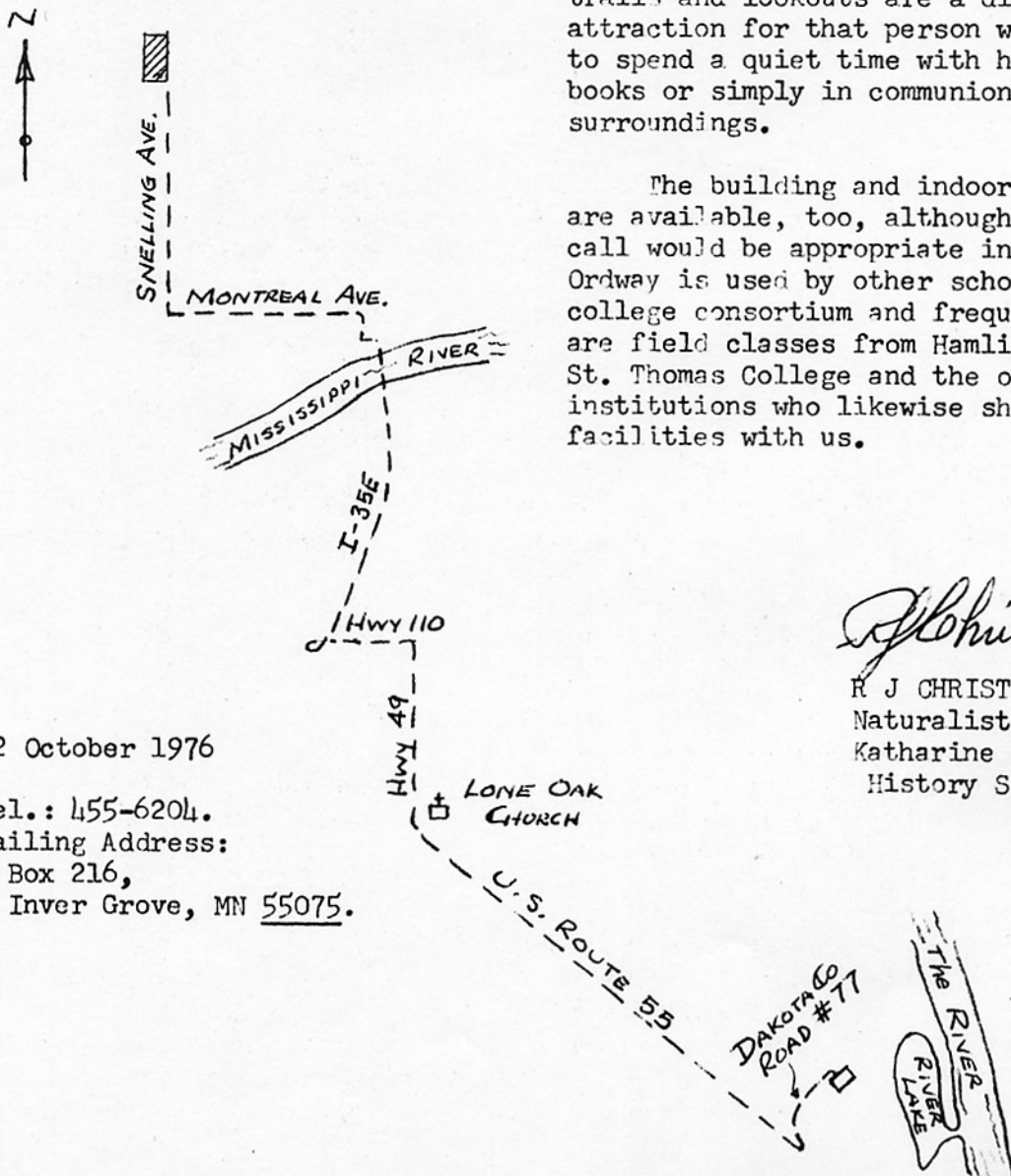
Subject: The TRAILS and FACILITIES at ORDWAY.
