The successful candidate will contribute to the undergraduate curriculum and will teach introductory, intermediate, and upper-level courses in Ancient-Medieval art and in other sub-specialties in the field, including a first year course and the senior Art History Methodology Seminar. The art history program is integrated with a vigorous studio program in a liberal arts undergraduate setting. Cross-listings with Classics, History, Middle Eastern Studies & Islamic Civilization, Religious Studies and other programs in the college are strongly encouraged.
