Postdoctoral Fellowship Economics

The Macalester College Department of Economics invites applications for two full-time (1.0 FTE) visiting faculty/postdoctoral fellows in the 2026-2027 academic year. Postdoctoral fellows will teach four courses per year. We seek candidates with strong commitment to high quality undergraduate teaching in any field of economics. While the area of expertise is open, teaching expectations will include core introductory level courses with opportunities to teach topics courses in the economist's areas of interest. The teaching load is four courses per year with a maximum of three course preparations. Visa sponsorship is not available for this position. Salary and benefits are competitive. ABD candidates will be considered. Visa sponsorship is not available for this position. In addition, candidates relying on an OPT Visa with a STEM extension are not eligible for hire.

Compensation and Benefits:

The starting salary range for this position will be \$85,000 and will depend upon teaching experience and highest degree attained.
