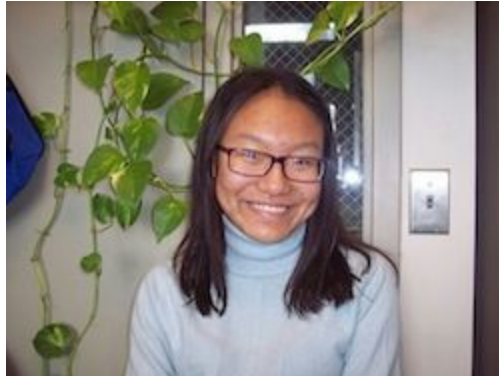

The Yale Early Social Cognition Lab at the Yale Child Study Center is interested in recruiting multiple highly qualified students from Macalester College for an exciting pre-doctoral fellowship for current graduates or graduating seniors. The position will commence June 2016.

Successful applicants will be involved in a 2-year training program involving clinical research experience. Fellows will be responsible for assisting in a variety of research activities in the lab and for completing experimental protocols with infants and toddlers and their families.
