Eric Wiertelak honored as Fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science

Eric P. Wiertelak, DeWitt Wallace Professor of Psychology and Director of Neuroscience Studies, has been named a Fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science (AAAS). Election as an AAAS Fellow is an honor bestowed upon AAAS members by their peers.

"I'm really honored each day to help students here and at other institutions achieve their goals for a liberal arts education by combining the interdisciplinary study of neuroscience with their other interests," said Wiertelak.

Initiated by the Section on Education, Wiertelak was elected as an AAAS Fellow for "distinguished contributions to the development of undergraduate neuroscience education, which have dramatically enhanced neuroscience education at colleges and universities across the United States." The tradition of AAAS Fellows began in 1874. These individuals have been elevated to this rank because of their efforts toward advancing science applications that are deemed scientifically or socially distinguished.

The American Association for the Advancement of Science (AAAS) is the world's largest general scientific society and publisher of the journal <u>Science</u> as well as <u>Science Translational Medicine</u>, <u>Science Signaling</u>, a digital, open-access journal, <u>Science Advances</u>, <u>Science Immunology</u>, and <u>Science Robotics</u>. AAAS was founded in 1848 and includes nearly 250 affiliated societies and academies of science, serving 10 million individuals. The non-profit <u>AAAS</u> is open to all and fulfills its mission to "advance science and serve society" through initiatives in science policy, international programs, science education, public engagement, and more.

Brett Campbell '15 oversees the non-human primate division of the Neurorestoration Research Center at the Cleveland Clinic. His translational research group focuses on novel applications of neurostimulation-based therapies for the treatment of neurological and psychiatric disease-specifically Parkinson's disease, stroke, and traumatic brain injury. His team was recently awarded a \$5 million UH3 grant as a part of President Obama's Brain Initiative for a clinical trial using deep brain stimulation for stroke recovery. Devin Palmer '15 writes "I am a Contractor for the US Army Medical Research Institute of Chemical Defense. I am a Laboratory Technician in a pharmacology lab specifying in neuroinflammation & neuroprotection as well as anticonvulsants. Additionally, I am the head behavioral researcher for our lab group. Currently in the publishing process for a first author published manuscript, which would be my first thus far, so I'm looking forward to that."
